Shepley went through to the second round of the Sykes Cup with a comfortable win over Broad Oak. Shepley batted first after winning the toss and the openers scored freely with Tom Denton, who went on to score 130, in imperious form. The

first wicket fell on 52, and the second shortly afterwards, but first Liam Wiles (25) and then Amar Rashid (scoring an aggressive 78 on his home debut) joined Denton in taking the score up to a very competitive 282-6. Broad Oak were soon in trouble as wickets from Danny (2-25) and Craig Glover (2-27), together with a smart run-out by Rashid, reduced the visitors to 40-5 after 15 overs. Freeland (73), Walker (24) and McCreadie (30*) played their shots against the spinners before Rashid (3-55) finished off the tail to see his team home by 102 runs.
