Wiles' departure led to a swift end to the innings, leaving a disappointing total and unused overs. Honley's reply seemed well on course at 68-2, but a clatter of wickets saw them looking at a nervous 98-7 with Danny Glover bowling an excellent spell. But Richard Jakeman did what he does and, supported by skipper Archie Moore, saw his team home, finishing the game with a huge six, shortly after reaching his fifty.
