Shepley bounced back from a disappointing first day of the season with a comfortable win over Kirkburton in the Heavy Woollen Cup first round. Kirkburton won the toss and batted on a pitch of uneven bounce, with an outfield of unusual growth. Kirkburton started steadily before Danny (2-32) and Craig Glover (2-57) each dismissed one of the openers. Ryan Robinson began to take the fight to the visitors, supported by wicket-keeper Smith. But some tight bowling in the middle section from Liam Wiles (2-30) and SP Singh (1-29) and a couple of crucial wickets from Ben Wells (2-42) restricted the hosts to 215-9. Shepley's reply was impressive. Tom Denton (18) began aggressively and Tim Rees (40) and Liam Wiles (28) followed suit. At the other end SP Singh (98*) built an excellent innings around which the others could play. A flurry of wickets left Shepley on 164-5 but, with some sensible batting from Nigel Hoyle and Craig Glover, Singh saw his side home with overs to spare.
