

Shepley v Barkisland
Drakes Huddersfield League Premiership
Sunday 16th May 2010
Marsh Lane, Shepley

At least two records were broken at Marsh Lane as Shepley secured a convincing win over Barkisland. The Shepley score of 365-5 was both the highest score by Shepley Cricket Club in any competitive first team game and the highest score by any team on the Shepley ground. It must also be possible that the third wicket stand of 254 between Tim Rees (119) and Liam Wiles (138) was a record itself.

Shepley started well as Tom Denton (35) and SP Singh (33) put on 69 for the first wicket, before both falling in quick succession. Rees and Wiles then set about the Barkisland bowling and took the game way beyond the visitors; cattle in the adjoining fields were peppered with fifteen sixes during the stand as the pair accelerated. Finally they were both dismissed, but Danny Glover (10) and Don Bandula Ranjith (22) continued the aerial onslaught.

Barkisland's challenge, already huge, became almost impossible as Leigh Millar (2-37) took two early wickets. Fraine, Bowett and Darren Robinson resisted, but SP Singh (5-43) had the last word as Shepley took maximum points by bowling out the visitors for 219.
