

**Shepley v Birstall**

Big spending Wrenthorpe visit Marsh Lane for a Heavy Woollen Cup Semi Final after Shepley's convincing win over Birstall. What had been predicted to be a close contest was effectively all over by the thirteenth over, by which time the visitors had limped to 19-5. Birstall's top order had no answer to Shepley's attack, losing a wicket to the first ball. Runs were almost impossible as Danny Glover (2-8), Leigh Millar (2-15), Don Bandula Ranjith (3-20) and SP Singh (3-26) took control, along with a memorable piece of fielding from Nigel Hoyle.

A score of 101 all out in 33 overs was never likely to be enough. The home side's reply was serene, with SP Singh passing 1000 runs for the season and Tom Denton (39) remarkably run out, before Tim Rees (17) and Liam Wiles (22\*) saw them home in just 21 overs.
