Shepley cruised to a straightforward nine-wicket win over struggling Broad Oak at Marsh Lane. The visitors won the toss and elected to bat, but were soon struggling to keep out the Glover boys, who shared the top six wickets between them as 47-1 rapidly became 63-6. Only wicketkeeper Gill, captain France and veteran Hurlbatt reached double figures. Spinners SP Singh and Amar Rashid mopped up the tail, with the help of a run out, as Broad Oak were bowled out for 108 in 36 overs.

Shepley's reply was clinical, led by Tom Denton in his last game of the season, and supported by Singh and Tim Rees. Denton finished the game with a six in just the seventeenth over, ensuring his side maximum points and a very early finish.
