Shepley achieved a comfortable six-point win against a disappointing Elland at Hullen Edge. Elland chose to bat after winning the toss but found runs difficult to come by as a score of 3-0 off 6 overs testifies. Leigh Millar (4-29) bowled particularly well, taking the first four wickets, including 3 in 2 overs as Elland slumped from 61-1 to 63-4. From that point Shepley were totally in control, caught their catches, and saw off the home side for 130 in 46 overs, as Danny Glover (3-49) took out the tail.

As long as the rain did not interfere Shepley were firm favourites, despite losing Tom Denton and Liam Wiles to interesting caught behind decisions. Tim Rees (68*) played beautifully and, with the help of veteran Nigel Hoyle (18*), saw his side home with seven wickets and over twenty-five overs to spare.
