

Shepley v Gomersal
 Heavy Woollen Cup Round Two

Shepley bounced back from the previous day's disappointment with a comfortable win over Bradford League side Gomersal in the Heavy Woollen Cup second round. Batting first, Shepley struggled at times. Tim Rees (36) batted beautifully after the early loss of Tom Denton, but he and SP Singh both fell with the score on 45. The batsmen continued to find runs difficult to come by and at 99-6 another poor day seemed possible. But Nigel Hoyle (38) turned the innings round with six boundaries before an explosive knock from Danny Glover (56), ably supported by Sam Denton (14*), took Shepley up to an improbable 217-9.

Gomersal's reply started in similar fashion as Liam Millar (2-21) and Danny Glover (1-15) saw off the top order, with only young Andrew Gorrad (30) resisting. Don Bandula Ranjith (4-15) took out the middle order, leaving Singh (2-22) to wrap things up as Gomersal were all out for 132 in the 42nd over.
