Shepley enjoyed a good win in Barnsley, but only after a nervous hour. Put into bat, Shepley overcame the early loss of Tom Denton to put them in a strong position. SP Singh (94) and Tim Rees (74) put on 161 for the 2nd wicket before Amar Rashid (19), Danny Glover (22*) and Nigel Hoyle (16*) played their shots to take the total to 276-5.

Judging par at Hoylandswaine is never easy, but when the Glover boys reduced the hosts to 69-6, Shepley seemed well in control. But former Shepley legend Don Bandula Ranjith had other ideas. Helped by the annoying Chris Schofield he scored an aggressive 74 as the pair put on 121 for the 7th wicket, before holing out to substitute fielder Jamie Dearnley. Schofield (51*) hung around, but Craig Glover (4-94) and Singh (2-36) bowled good spells late on to finish things off.
