

Shepley v Slaithwaite

Shepley moved smoothly through to their second major final of the season with a seven wicket Heavy Woollen semi final victory over Slaithwaite. The visitors won the toss and elected to bat, but memories of the previous day's troubles must have rushed back as Craig Glover (2-15) sent back both Taylor and Holt with just 10 on the board. SP Singh (2-23) took out Connors, but the introduction of Liam Wiles (3-18) with two wickets in his first over put Shepley firmly in control. Opener Wajid Hussain (54*) carried his bat, but none of his colleagues could hang on long enough as Amar Rashid (2-21) took two more wickets to help finish off the innings.

Shepley scored briskly in reply before Singh (18) was out, but not before he had completed his 1000 runs in all fifty-over games this season. Tom Denton (39) and Wiles (33) took their side to the cusp of victory, leaving Rashid to finish things off with a massive six.
