

**Shepley v Woodlands**

Shepley scored an excellent win over a strong Woodlands side to go through to the semi-finals of the Heavy Woollen Cup for the second consecutive year. The Bradford League side won the toss and batted, but were soon under pressure. Danny Glover (4-41) took out openers Richardson and Frankland with just 17 on the board, whilst brother Craig (1-18) conceded just one run off the bat in his first seven overs. All the bowlers contributed as only Simon Mason (40) of the top order made an impact, before Peter Swanepoel (41) and Safraz Ahmed (48) helped the visitors reach a decent 222-9 off their fifty overs.

SP Singh went early and Tim Rees got an interesting decision, but a top knock from Tom Denton (75) held the innings together, as Liam Wiles (29) and Ben Wells (33) made important contributions, before Huw Ellis (25\*) and Danny Glover (20\*) saw their side home with almost three overs to spare.
